Local Sightseeing

The hotel can organise visits to many tourist destinations, including:

- **Har Ki Pauri:** Recognised as one of the most sacred Ghats in Haridwar, it is frequented by devotees seeking the blessings of the Holy Ganga. Har Ki Pauri, which roughly translates to "Steps to Lord Shiva," is one of the four places where the drops of elixir were accidentally spilt by the celestial bird, Garuda.
- **Mansa Devi Temple:** This well-known temple is devoted to the goddess Mansa Devi, believed to be a type of Shakti, who arose from Lord Shiva's thoughts. The temple, also known as Bilwa Tirth, is located on top of the Bilwa Parvat in the Shivalik Hills.
- **Chandi Devi Temple:** This temple, devoted to the Chandi Devi Goddess, is nestled on the Shivalik Hills' Neel Parvat. It is one of Haridwar's five pilgrimages and a Siddha Peetha, a place where devotees worship to fulfil their desires. The Chandi Devi temple is also a popular destination with trekkers due to its location. A ropeway can also be used to reach the temple's pinnacle, which offers breathtaking views.

- **Daksh Mahadev Temple:** Daksha Mahadev Temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva, is in Kankhal, Haridwar. It is named after Sati's father, King Daksha Prajapti. The Daksha Mahadev Temple is not very old, but the yajnas, or location where yajnas (fire sacrifices) are performed, is quite old and has been authenticated as the location where the original Sati gave up her life for the sake of her husband, who had been insulted by her father.
- **Shanti Kunj:** Shanti Kunj, near Haridwar, is a world-renowned ashram and the headquarters of the All World Gayatri Pariwar (AWGP). This pilgrimage centre, a school for social and spiritual awakening, has educated millions of people about spiritual principles. It strives to revive Rishi traditions by providing training to the masses based on divine concepts.
- **Sapt Rishi Ashram:** This Ashram derived its name from Hindu mythology according to which seven great sages Vashishth, Kashyap, Atri, Vishwamitra, Gautam, Bharadwaja, and Jamadagni met in this place to meditate. The site is located on the bank of the Ganges and is also the point at which the river separates into seven different streams known as saptosarovars.
