The district is a sprawling suburb that stretches into Shivapuri Nagarjun National Park, home to leopards, monkeys, and bears, plus many species of local and migratory birds. The major tourist attractions around the district are Pashupatinath Temple, Buddha Stupa, Durbar Square, Hanuman Dhoka, Narayanhiti Palace and more.

The inviting interiors and the inspiring artwork of this hotel make for a setting that is refreshing, contemporary and stylish, while still reflecting a touch of the city's heritage and culture.

Local Sightseeing

The hotel can organise visits to many tourist destinations, including:

- **Pashupatinath Temple:** This temple is dedicated to Lord Pashupati and is currently the largest and oldest temple in the world. The temple is located in Kathmandu, Nepal near the Bagmati River.
- **Buddhanilkantha Temple:** Situated below the Shivapuri hill, in the northern part of Kathmandu, the temple is dedicated to Lord Vishnu and is also known as Narayanthan temple and Jal Narayan temple. The statue of Budhanilkantha is also the largest stone carving of Nepal.
- **Narayanhiti Palace:** The palace is a public museum and was created in 2008 in Kathmandu, Nepal. It was built by King Mahendra in 1963, and incorporates an impressive array of courtyards, gardens and buildings. The name, "Narayanhiti" is made up of two words 'Narayana' and 'Hiti'. Narayan is the Hindu god, Vishnu, and a temple dedicated to him lies opposite the palace. Hiti is a "water spout" in Newar language and there is one to the east of the main entrance in the precincts of the palace, a landmark that features prominently in local legends

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- **Thamel:** Thamel is a buzzing, visitor-friendly and vibrant neighbourhood that is recognised for its short lanes filled with a diverse selection of stores, vendors, restaurants, and pubs.
- **Buddha Stupa:** From its whitewashed dome to its gilded tower painted with the all-seeing eyes of the Buddha, the monument is perfectly proportioned. The highly symbolic construction, in essence, is a three-dimensional reminder of the Buddha's path towards enlightenment.
- **Hanuman Dhoka:** Kathmandu's royal palace, known as the Hanuman Dhoka, was originally built during the Licchavi period. Cloaked in red and sheltered by an umbrella, a Hanuman statue marks the dhoka (entrance) to the Hanuman Dhoka which gives the palace its name. The statue dates from 1672 and the god's face has long disappeared under a coating of orange vermillion paste applied by generations of devotees.
